## AGE GUIDELINES

This table gives an overview for new students to see which graded classes it would be most appropriate for them to join.

Some classes, like our vocational (intermediate foundation upwards) and pre-pointe classes are usually invitation only as they require higher levels of commitment. Others not listed in this guide, like contemporary, are mixed ability but have limited availability.

CLASS LEVEL	AGE
Pre-school	3 upwards (Younger students at managements discretion, must be potty trained and confident.)
Pre-Primary	4 upwards (Students must have started school, and can take this exam no earlier than 5.)
Primary	6 upwards (Students can take this exam no earlier than 6.)
Grades 1-5	7 upwards (Students can take these exams no earlier than 7.)
Junior Contemporary	9 upwards (Or when students have started Grade 3 Ballet.)
Grades 6-8	13 upwards (Students can take these exams no earlier than 11. Adults are welcome to join classes of this level at management's discretion. Email for details.)
Intermediate Foundation	11 upwards (Students are invited to join this class on the strength of their work in other classes. Adults are welcome to join classes of this level at management's discretion. Email for details.)
Intermediate - Advanced	12 upwards (Students are invited to join this class on the strength of their work in other classes. Adults are welcome to join classes of this level at management's discretion. Email for details.)
Senior Contemporary	13 upwards (Or when students have started Grade 6 Ballet.)
