

INFORMATION FOR NEW PUPILS

- Prospective pupils are welcome to join for a trial class to make sure that they are happy and settled before making a firm commitment.
- It is desirable that children have the correct uniform as soon as possible after they begin regular classes.
- Within class, children work and concentrate much better without an audience. Specially organised "Parent Watching Days" therefore only occur every other term. In all other circumstances, Parents can wait in the entrance areas and cloakrooms of class venues before collecting their child, though "Special Visitors" are welcome on request.
- o **Hair** should be neat and tidy. Long hair should be tied back and pinned in a bun. Medium length hair should also be held out of the face with a bun or other suitable style.
- o **RAD Examinations** can be taken. You will receive an entry form should we recommend your child partake in an examination, but there is *no obligation* to enter. Children who *are* entered will then be requested to take an extra class a week in preparation.
- Fees are payable on the first day of term. Please enclose your account for receipt purposes.

- For those taking classes on a Saturday, please remember the area behind the Welfare Centre is for the use of garage tenants only, so do not block the garage entrances.
- Ballet is a physical art form and some physical contact may be necessary to explain body movement and avoid injury

ENROLMENT

Once enrolled students are permanently registered with Brewer Dance Academy and there is no need to re-enrol from term to term.

Should you wish to discontinue classes half a term's written notice is required. For example, notice must be given at May half term if lessons are not required in September.
