

WHAT DOES A CASA DO?

1

Petition filed alleging dependency, neglect, or abuse.

2

Judge appoints CASA to the child.

3

CASA volunteer meets the child and gets to know them.

4

CASA visits the child at least once a month.

5

CASA communicates with everyone involved in the child's case.

(parent, foster parents, DCBS, teachers, doctors, counselors, and others)

6

CASA advocates for the child's best interest in court.

7

CASA remains on the case with the child until permanency.
