Messineo (Victim) was offering an evening (PM) meat mush paddy to Western Adult Cougar, Known as "Mickey", thru 4" x 4" wire panel opening(s), by hand toss delivery, from outside of wire mesh openings, and thru mesh panel openings.

The meat paddy broke into several pieces upon presentation; some of contents fell inside enclosure(Dirt floor with Landscape pave present), and some of it fell outside of enclosure.

Messineo state she then picked up residual meat mush paddy, reformed it, and was attempting to deliver it, by hand toss, thru wire mesh openings.

Allegedly the Cougar targeted hand of Messineo containing the meat mush paddy. Messineo retracted hand rapidly, likely brushing against the exterior plane of the wire mesh panels. Messineo stated no contact with Cougar was ever made. No witnesses present during this feeding as all other personnel had left for the day.

This event was not reported to staff until several days later. See Investigation Narrative.

On March 3, 2016, Lt. Steve De Lacure and myself met at the location listed above known as Big Cat Rescue to conduct a follow-up investigation related to IBE 16-010.

At this location we were met by Carole Baskin, Owner / Manager who escorted us to the enclosure that contained the Western Cougar named in the IBE. We viewed the area where Messineo stated she was standing / kneeling when she was injured.

At the enclosure we observed all wire to be intact and no damage. This enclosure is constructed of 4" X 4" square welded wire and meets the requirements set forth in the FAC governing caging.

During a thorough examine of the feeding area, several barbs on the wires surface were located, this occurs during the manufacturing process. These sharp burrs may have caused the minor injury that Lt. De Lacure observed during his interview with Messineo.

It should also be noted at throughout the entire facility there are sections of wire fence that have very sharp edges and this is also addressed in the release from liability form that each person must sign prior to entering the grounds. Signage is also present in many area's ref leaning on the wire.

We then viewed the records related to the Cougar and verified its point of origin and that it had received a rabies vaccination when it arrived at Big Cat Rescue on 8/7/2014. In the records it was noted that the Cougar had it's from claws removed on its front paws. All other records were up to date and no violations were observed.

It should be noted that this facility had been inspected on the date of the alleged bite by this Investigator and Investigator Chad Paul.

As of March 3, 2016, Messineo had still not contacted Carole Baskin, nor had she completed an Incident Form required by the facility.

This investigation is closed with no further action.
