- "It's nothing personal, it's just business"



# What is a Cash-Secured Put Option?

- A Cash-Secured Put Option is the safest way to Sell Options.
- It involves "putting" up the money to secure the Strike Price of the option all the way to zero.
- Let's say that the price of BAC is currently \$39.77 per share.
- Each \$40 Put Option we sell represents 100 shares of stock.
- We need to "Put Up" \$4,000 to sell this option.

#### A Real-Life Example: Bank of America 12-Month Chart



#### The PTP Difference

- Cash-Secured Puts versus Buy and Hold.
- 12- Month ROI for Buy & Hold is 3.58%
- Selling weekly "puts" at 1% turns a potential 3.58% profit into a 54.93% ROI.
- We track over 20 potential companies to utilize this technique.

#### How Do We Know This Will Work?

- The Total Investment by all partners related to Selling Put Options was \$118,000.
- At the High-Water Mark in June of 2021 the LP's balance was \$366,584.72.
- This is an unrealized gain of \$248,584, or 210.66%.
- Account Statements are available to verify these results.

### What Was the Final Result?

- The total withdrawals were \$233,502.
- Our realized gain was \$115,502 or 97.88% over an eight-month period.
- Overall equity toward the end of trading was very "turbulent" due to extreme market volatility.
