

# The Bay Area Mortuary Services General Price List

Effective November 1, 2023

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services (included in package prices). If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to the drafting of any contract for goods or services, the responsible party, the decedent's survivor or whoever is handling the funeral arrangements, is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need arrangement in possession of the funeral establishment has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent

## Basic Services \$1,055

This is the basic charge to each family we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, traditional service selections, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains). This also includes an arrangement conference, preparation of death certificate and health department permit, coordination with clergy, cemetery, air carriers, notification of Veterans Administration and Social Security, and all other outside services.

## Embalming \$775

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

## A. Traditional Burial \$4,325

Includes basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, local transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroners office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering (up to 7 days), embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hour Chapel Service, Banquet Room, funeral coach, transfer to a local cemetery, for graveside service.

## Graveside \$2,990

Includes basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, local transfer of decedent from place of death, sheltering (3 days), funeral coach, transfer to local cemetery, and the graveside service. (Not including flowers & casket)

## Immediate Burial \$2,165

Includes basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, local transfer of decedent from place of death, sheltering (3 days), delivery to local cemetery in a utility vehicle, no services, no family present. (Not including flowers & casket)

## Receiving Remains \$1,775

Includes basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, transfer from San Jose International Airport, scheduled delivery to local cemetery. (In a utility vehicle, no services, no family present).

## Forwarding Remains \$2,440

Includes basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, local transfer of decedent from place of death, embalming, combo unit and transfer of decedent to San Jose International Airport.

## Direct Cremation \$1,710

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, basic container for cremation, plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate and cremation disposition permit. \*\*

## Witnessed Cremation \$2,900

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, tray view for cremation, wash, feature set, and dressing of Decedent, 20 minute viewing of deceased either at the mortuary or crematory, transport to crematory, witnessed cremation fees, return of the cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate and cremation disposition permit. \*\*

## Oversized Cremation (300 lbs. +) \$2,350

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, reinforced container for cremation, oversized cremation fees, transport to the crematory, return of cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate and cremation disposition permit. \*\*

## Traditional Service with Cremation \$4,685

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, shelter of remains up to 7 days, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hr Chapel Service, Banquet Room, transport to crematory, cremation fees, return of cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate and cremation disposition permit. \*\*

## Traditional Service with Witnessed \$4,950

Cremation Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hr Chapel Service, Banquet Room, funeral coach, transfer to crematory, witnessed cremation fees, witnessed cremation service, return of the cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate and cremation disposition permit. \*\*

## Other Cremation Options

Per California State law, all human remains received for cremation must be contained in a rigid, combustible container. Alternative containers encase the decedent and can be made of fire-board or composite materials with or without an outside covering. The containers we provide are constructed of hardwoods, composite material and/or heavy cardboard.
