

Bay Area Mortuary Services General Price List

Effective June 1, 2020 – Cash Discount / Credit Card Price

The goods and services shown here are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead (this fee is included in package prices). If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to the drafting of any contract for goods or services, the responsible party, the decedent's survivor, or whoever is handling the funeral arrangements, is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need agreement in possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

Basic Services **\$945 / \$970**

This is the basic charge for our professional expertise and includes the following services: conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary documents; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our packet charges for Direct Cremations, Immediate Burials, and Forwarding or Receiving of remains.)

Embalming **\$595 / \$610**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing, is selected. Embalming is performed by a California licensed embalmer and usually enhances the appearance of the decedent. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Traditional Burial Service **\$3,295 / \$3,395**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hour Chapel Service, funeral coach, transfer to cemetery and the graveside service. (Does not include casket, church fees, flowers, merchandise, disposition permit or death certificates)

Graveside Service **\$2,595 / \$2,675**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, funeral coach, transfer to local cemetery and the graveside service. (Does not include casket, flowers, merchandise, disposition permit or death certificates)

Immediate Burial **\$1,945 / \$2,005**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, delivery to local cemetery in a utility vehicle, no services, no family or friends present. (Does not include casket, flowers, merchandise, disposition permit or death certificates)

Receiving Remains **\$1,595 / \$1,645**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from San Jose Int'l Airport, filing for burial permit, scheduled delivery to local cemetery in a utility vehicle, no services, no family or friends present. (Does not include casket, flowers, merchandise, disposition permit or death certificates)

Forwarding Remains **\$2,095 / \$2,160**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, embalming, combo unit and transfer of Decedent to San Jose Int'l Airport.

International Documentation Processing **from \$250 / \$265**

Direct Cremation **\$1,495 / \$1,540**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, basic container for cremation, transport to crematory, cremation fee, return of cremated remains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate* and cremation disposition permit. (Home/residential removal additional)

Witnessed Cremation **\$2,220 / \$2,285**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, basic container for cremation, wash, feature set, and dressing of Decedent, 20 minute viewing of deceased either at the mortuary or crematory, transport to crematory, witnessed cremation fees, return of the cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate* and cremation disposition permit. (Home/residential removal additional)

Oversized Cremation (300 lbs. +) **\$2,120 / \$2,180**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, reinforced container for cremation, oversized cremation fees, transport to the crematory, return of cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate* and cremation disposition permit. (Home/residential removal additional)

Traditional Service with Cremation **\$3,620 / \$3,730**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of decedent hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, shelter of remains up to 7 days, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hr Chapel Service, transport to crematory, cremation fees, return of cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate* and cremation disposition permit. (Home/residential removal additional. Evening and weekend services additional. Does not include casket, church/clergy honorarium, flowers or merchandise)

Traditional Service with Witnessed Cremation **\$3,870 / \$3,985**

Includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of Decedent from local hospital, Coroner's Office, convalescent/nursing home, sheltering of remains up to 7 days, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, 3 hr Chapel Service, funeral coach, transfer to crematory, witnessed cremation fees, witnessed cremation service, return of the cremains in a plastic utility urn, 1 certified death certificate* and cremation disposition permit. (Home/residential removal additional. Evening and weekend services additional. Does not include casket, church/clergy honorarium, flowers or merchandise)

Other Cremation Options

Per California State law, all human remains received for cremation must be contained in a rigid, combustible container. Alternative containers encase the decedent and can be made of fireboard or composite materials (with or without an outside covering) The containers we provide are constructed of hardwoods, composite material and/or heavy cardboard
