1. Policy Statement



Creative Threads Cornwall CIC is committed to minimising our environmental impact and promoting sustainability in all areas of our work. 2. Our Commitments

Sustainable Sourcing

- Offcuts and surplus items will be reused in future sessions or donated to community partners.

Energy and Resource Efficiency

- We will use community venues that demonstrate good environmental practices where possible.
- Staff and volunteers will be encouraged to reduce energy use, conserve water, and travel sustainably.

• Community Education and Engagement

- Through our workshops, we will raise awareness of environmental issues, showing how creative reuse and recycling can reduce costs and protect the planet.
- We will share resources and ideas with participants to help them continue sustainable practices beyond our sessions.

3. Monitoring and Improvement

- We will review our environmental practices annually and seek feedback from staff, volunteers, and participants.
- We will set achievable goals for reducing waste, increasing reuse, and sourcing more sustainably each year.
- We will stay informed about best practice in sustainability and adapt our approach accordingly.
