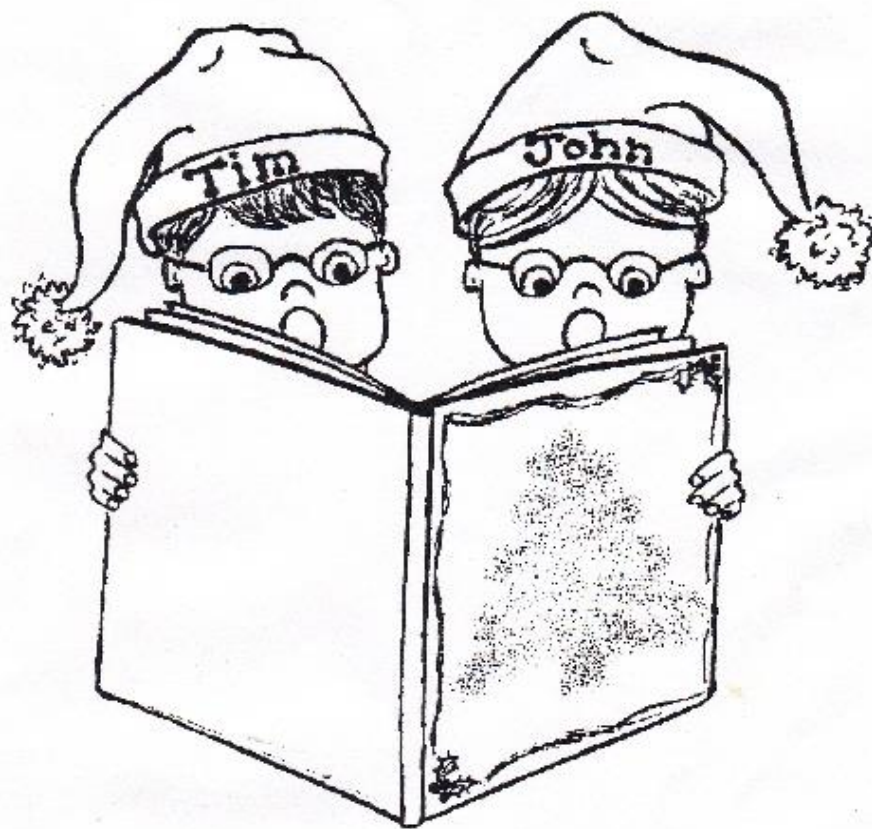

Away In A Manger

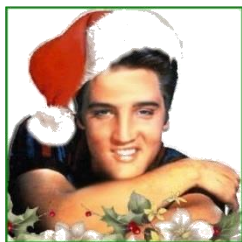
Away in a manger no crib for His bed

Santa Claus is coming to town

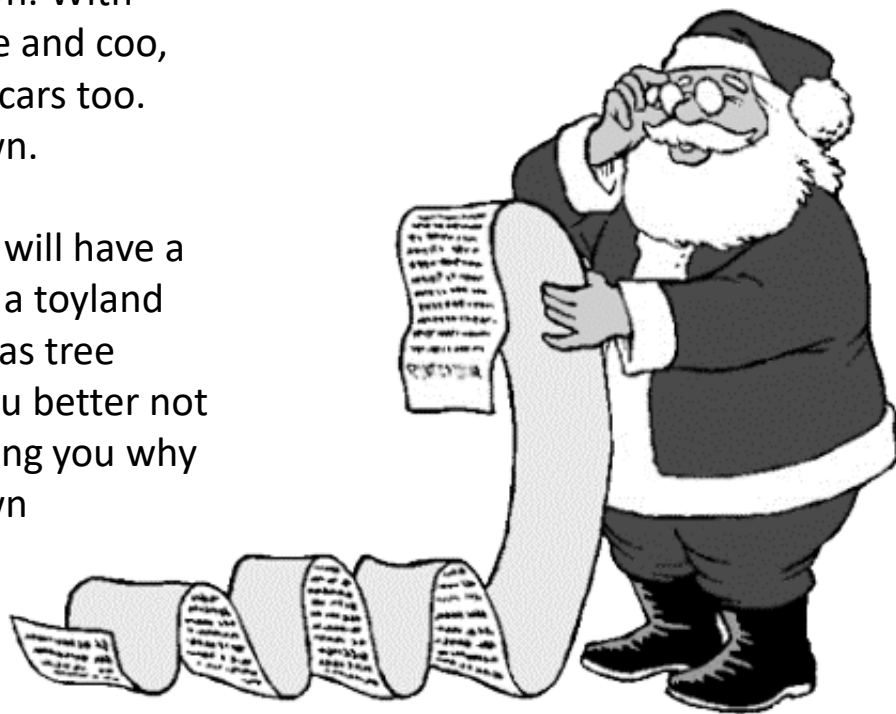
Silent Night
