

OCC suggestions for your clone(s):

- 1- When you get home, we recommend quarantining any new plant for a couple days and thoroughly spraying with Neem oil and/or any other organically made pest/mold/disease preventative that you find effective for your micro-climate (we do not recommend the use of non-organic products).
- 2- Transplant your clone into a bigger pot (at least one gallon - the bigger the pot, the bigger the yield) using fresh organic soil. We recommend using products in addition to an organic soil mix to maximize performance, such as Mycorrhizae, earth worm castings, and teas.
- 3- Join or browse a grow forum online to learn more grow tips about your preferred grow style. You can learn anything here (rollitup.org, icmag.com, opengrow.com, etc.).
- 4- The number one mistake growers make is overwatering. Have big holes in your pots for drainage.
- 5- Plants are living beings! The more time and love you put into them, the healthier they will be. Spend a few minutes twice a day with your plants. It's meditative!
