Tasks of the Plan Consultant will include: aggregate watershed information, notify plan review authorities and host kick-ff meeting, write the land and water resources narrative, identify and prioritize resources and issues, establish measurable goals, develop a targeted implementation schedule, describe implementation programs, determine plan administration and coordination, write the draft plan for review, outreach/facilitation, conduct formal plan review, and write/submit final plan to BWSR. (\$169,500)

The Steering Team is identified to assist with these tasks: aggregate watershed information, notify plan review authorities and host kick-ff meeting, outreach/facilitation and other planning activities, and conduct formal plan review, (\$15,500)

Establishing Measurable Goals and Developing Targeted Implementation Plan go hand-in-hand to accurately predict the actions needed to reach the estimated goals within the given budget. The Plan is progressing according to Timeline goals.

December 30, 2024 - \$18,500 was added to this activity from the Planning & Assessment Contingency activity to cover approved expenditures 12/30/2024 3:33:34 PM with the remaining grant funds. At the November 20, 2024 Policy Committee meeting, approval was given to Houston Engineering, Inc. for:

\$12,000 for MS4Front Tracking System development; and

\$7,990 for BEAST (Benefits Estimator & Spreadsheet Tool) development;

up to \$50,000 for a Hydrological Model (~100 subwatersheds) to focus on water storage locations.

The Cottonwood-Middle Minnesota Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan was approved by the BWSR Southern Region Committee on 12/9/2024.
