- Updated RCRCA Website Created CWMM WBIF Implementation Grant Section and will maintain the site monthly to post meeting announcements, approved minutes, and other information.
- Attended Cover Crop Field Day in Windom August 19th
- Attended the final CW-MM Planning Grant Policy Committee Meeting August 20th
- Distributed most of the printed Plans to the SWCDs and counties.
- Created monthly financial reporting spreadsheets one for Policy Committee and one for Technical Committee. These spreadsheets will track projects/contracts as well as all expenditures of the WBIF grant.
- Scheduled Tech Committee virtual meeting on Sept 17th for discussions on how implementation is going so far, adequacy of the Scoring/Ranking sheet, CRP Incentive update by Redwood SWCD, and demonstration on entering a project through MS4Front as a group so expectations from each other are known. Both the SWCD/county and Williams will have data to enter.
- Entered all currently-approved projects in MS4Front. Intend to use MS4 for all document submissions to RCRCA starting in October for consistency and ease. Emailed questions to Houston Engineering, Inc. as some inconsistencies were found in the software. HEI was undergoing a system-wide update for MS4Front so the inconsistencies may be resolved once this update is complete.
- Familiarized myself with the WBIF grant in eLINK and will be solely responsible for entering data and reports.

CW-MM WBIF – Disbursal of Grant Proceeds. An agreement has been received from Redwood County. This agreement allows RCRCA to pay these entities from the WBIF grant for staff time reimbursements for Project Development and Technical Assistance. Motion by Wakefield, seconded by Carter, to authorize the chairman's and executive director's signatures. Motion carried unanimously.

Other Business: The next CWMM-WBIF grant (FY26-27) will be increasing to \$1,971,082.
