Prosecco, Canella Conegliano, Italy ~ Crisp, fruity, snappy, and fun with delicate apple and almond scents **27**

Prosecco, Tiamo Italy ~ Charming aromas of apple, pears and gardenia flowers. Bright, fresh and fruity. split **9**

Cava, Raventos I Blanc Spain ~ Sparkling Spanish Cava at its best. Produced in same style as Champagne. Dry, toasty and focused. First producer of Cava and family owned since 1497. **34**

Champagne, Tattinger Brut la Francaise ~ Signature cuvee of this family owned winery. Exudes finesse and elegance, delicate nose, hints of honey and fresh fruit **62**

White

Pinot Grigio, Cabert Italy 2015 ~ Well balanced dry wine with notes of ripe apple, hint of almond at finish. **6 18**

Pinot Grigio, Bottega Vineaia Trentino region of Italy ~ Fresh and crisp with a floral perfume of an intensity and persistence rare in a Pinot Grigio. Limited production **30**

Verdicchio, Tavignano Marche, Italy 2016 ~ Young, expressive, and easy to drink. Aromas of fresh fruits, almonds, flowers, and spices. **9.50 26.00**

Sancerre, Henry Natter, Loire France 2015 ~ From the upper Loire where limestone is prevalent, this wine is made with 100 % Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Grapefruit and black current bud undertones accent the nose. Soft, supple, and refreshing palate with lovely, fruit driven length. Dry. **37.50**

Fume Blanc, Ferrari Carrano Sonoma, CA 2016 ~ Bright acidity and crisp freshness mingle perfectly with aroma and flavors of yellow peach, pear, Meyer lemon and mango. Great depth and complexity. **10.50 29**

Chardonnay, Parducci Mendocino County, CA 2016 Notes of Asian pear, wildflower honey and crisp honey with a creamy vanilla ~ caramel finish **8 24**

Chardonnay, Prescription Sacramento Valley, CA ~ Big, rich and buttery, with tones of citrus, lemon peel and tropical fruits. The wine barrels are toasted which creates a slightly smoky finish **33.25**

Chardonnay, Wrath Monterey, CA 2013 Earthy, dense, expansive and layered. Bright and clean. Personality of growing site and high quality of vintage are evidenced in balance and complexity. Highly rated. **68**

Moscato, 7 Daughters Italy ~ Bright, fruity aromas of golden raisin and apricot with a crisp, fruity sweet, medium body and tangy honey pear citrus finish. A tasty, sweet sipper. **8.25 23**

Pomelo, Napa Valley, CA 2016 luscious and refreshing, summer strawberry and juicy watermelon and raspberry flavors are balanced by crisp acidity on the finish **6.50 18.00**

Gérard Bertrand, Cote des Roses Languedoc region of France 2016 ~ Embodies the Mediterranean Art de Vivre. Fresh and fruity, best at 50 degrees. **38.50**

Reds

Pinot Noir, Bichot Secret de Famille Bourgogne, France 2014 ~ From a highly rated French producer this “burgundy” pinot noir has a charming nose of black currant, silky mouth feel and lingering finish. Dry. **42**

Pinot Noir, Erath Oregon 2015 ~ soft and very approachable, appeals to both red and white wine drinkers. **11 32**

Merlot, Stephen Vincent North Coast, CA 2012 ~ Lush fruit notes with finish of vanilla **24**

Cabernet, Caymus Napa Valley, 2014 This vintage continues the family’s focus on creating a singular “Caymus” expression of Cabernet, and one they are very proud of. Dry **145**

Cabernet, Duckhorn Napa Valley, 2013 ~ Embodies complexity of the valley while offering a seamless balance between fruit, oak and tannins. Dry. **115**

Cabernet, Textbook Napa Valley 2014 ~ Classic bordelaise winemaking yields an impeccably balanced and pure flavor of this classic Napa cabernet. Dry. Wonderfully smooth mouth feel. **48**

Cabernet, Alexander Brown Uncaged CA North Coast 2013 ~ Rich aromas of black cherry and mocha. Bold tannins frame a powerful, mid palate flavor layered with blackberry, black currant and chocolate as well as subtle hint of baking spices. Smooth and balanced with an elegant finesse that defines the long and lingering finish. **33**

Cabernet, Broadside Paso Robles, CA 2014 ~ Strong showing of cassis and classic blue fruit, with aromas of black cherry and subtle oak tinged spice. Rich black current and plum notes. Dry, delicate acidity. **8 24.75**

Red Blend, Peirano Estate Illusion 2015 ~ Deep burgundy tone with aromas of chocolate, black currant, plum’s and dark fruits. Medium finish **7.50 22**

Red Blend, Meritage, Lyeth Sonoma County 2014 ~ Abundant aromas of black cherry and cinnamon, succulent plum and cassis. Long, lasting finish. First winery in CA to create a Meritage. **41.25**

Red Blend, Paydirt, Going for Broke Paso Robles, CA 2015 ~ Bursting with freshness and ripe berry fruit, the Zinfandel provides a soft, round, and juicy base; the Syrah is deep, spicy and saturated. The Petit Sirah, Grenache and Mourvedre provide the perfect blend of aromatics: dark fruit, leather and spices. Tannins well defined and balanced. **41**

Red Blend, The Prisoner Napa Valley 2014 ~ Highly rated dry red blend of mainly Zinfandel and Cabernet grapes with aromas of black cherries and plums followed by complex and velvety flavors. **73**

Zinfandel, Peirano Old Vines CA 2014 ~ Classic style Zinfandel with some vines over 80 years old. Dry. **21**

Malbec, La Posta Pizzella Argentina ~ Dry and dense, with dark berry flavors and hints of spice **27.50**
