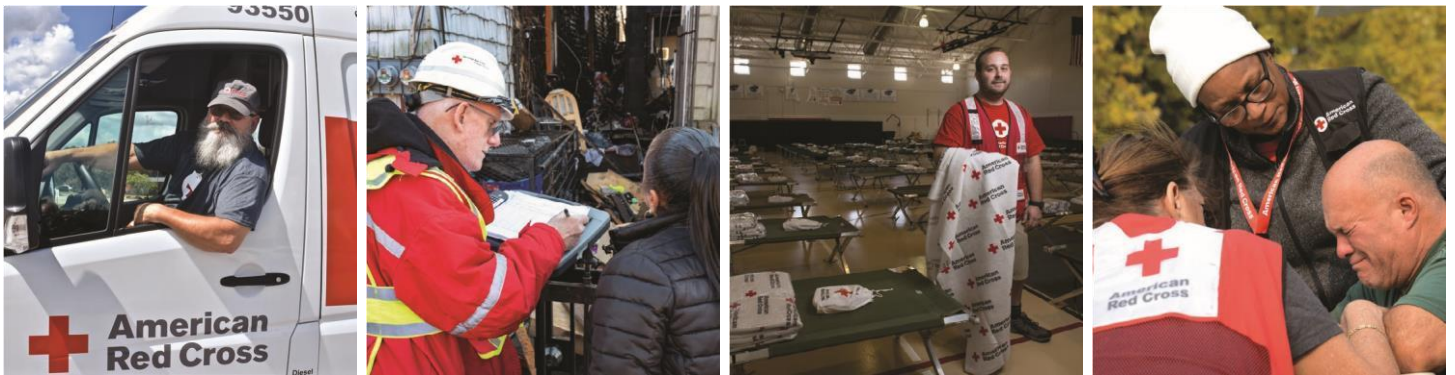


Turn Compassion Into Action!
