#### **SUBJECT: Booster Shots Available for Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson**

Lassen County residents who received any of the three COVID-19 vaccines are now eligible for a booster shot if they meet new criteria outlined below.

**A Pfizer or Moderna** booster dose is recommended if you:

- Received your second dose at least six months ago, and
- Are 65 or older, or
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings, or
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions, or
- Age 18+ who are at increased risk due to social inequity, or
- Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings

**A Johnson & Johnson** booster dose is recommended if you:

- Received your first dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least 2 months ago, and
- Are 18 or older

In line with the CDC, high-risk jobs are defined as:

- First responders (healthcare workers, firefighters, police, congregate care staff)
- Education staff (teachers, support staff, daycare workers)
- Food and agriculture workers
- Manufacturing workers
- Corrections workers
- U.S. Postal Service workers
- Public transit workers
- Grocery store workers
