CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	All containment lines on the fire are holding and fire activity was minimal overnight. Crews are reinforcing and patrolling the fire lines, and extinguishing hot spots within the fire perimeter. The incident is in areas with private residences, ranches and commercial operations. There are cultural and sensitive resources that remain threatened. Damage assessment teams have completed field inspections of the fire area and the final report is complete. All personnel assigned to the incident will continue to follow current COVID safety protocols.
