To date, the Lassen County COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) total tests are as follows:

- 0 – Known cases
- 33 - Negative
- 8 - Pending
- 41 – Total Tests

Testing is currently available and taking place in Lassen County. Testing is being completed based on health care providers' orders. Health care providers may not find it necessary to order tests for individuals that are experiencing mild to moderate symptoms. If you are exhibiting any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 (novel coronavirus), patients are encouraged to contact their health care providers prior to showing up to any medical facility. Please continue to follow the executive orders from Governor Newsom and participate in social distancing to keep our community safe.
