To date, the Lassen County COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) total tests are as follows:

It has come to the attention of the Incident Command team that some residents have been contacted by an out of state delivery service that delivers into Lassen County relaying information about their driver that tested positive for COVID-19 (novel coronavirus). Based on the investigation by the county health department, it has been confirmed that a driver that has made deliveries to Lassen County later tested positive for COVID-19 (novel coronavirus). We learned that April 3, 2020 was the last time the driver delivered to Lassen County. The Incident Command team will continue to be in contact with the company in order to monitor the situation and provide information to the public as necessary.

The Lassen COVID-19 Incident Command wants to remind the public to adhere to social distancing and handwashing when interacting with delivery service employees. Many residents receive deliveries with products from out of the area.

In light of these events, the public is asked to follow simple guidelines when accepting a delivery to limit exposure to COVID-19 (novel coronavirus).

- Don't shake hands with the driver
- Maintain a distance of at least six feet with the driver
- Wash your hands for at least twenty seconds after handling any package
- Clean surfaces where packages have touched
