As part of our Homecoming festivities, we are forming a **Homecoming Choir** made up of past and present MMBC choir members.

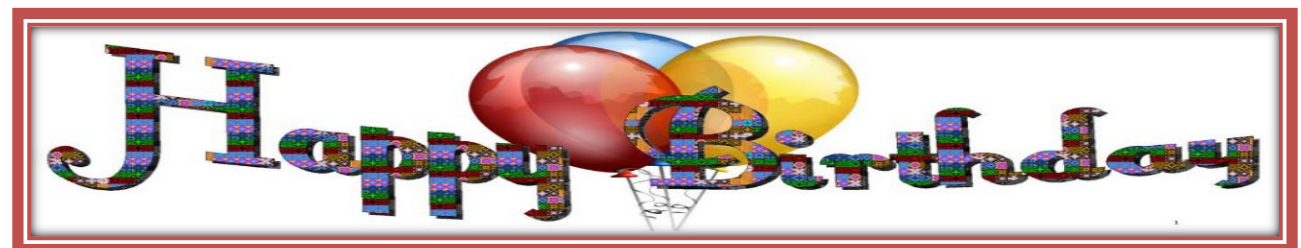
