



Tuition Payment Policy

The aim of this policy is to establish a fair, consistent, and transparent approach to the payment of tuition fees. It is designed to support a positive and respectful relationship between parents and the school by ensuring that everyone clearly understands the expectations and procedures.

As a tuition-based institution, The Learning Tree relies on the timely and reliable collection of fees to continue providing high-quality education. This policy ensures that all parties are aware of and follow a standardized process, promoting equity and accountability for all families.

Tuition Fees Based on 201 Teaching Days and 8 Hours of Contact Per Day

Full-Day Program K1 (2 years old) to Year 6 (11 years old): \$1800 per year.

Half-Day Program K1 and K2: \$960 per year.

Payment options

We offer several discounts to support families and encourage long-term commitment. Tuition fees must be paid in full before the first day of the school year or term. Students with any outstanding balance will not be permitted to start or return to school until the balance is cleared.

Yearly payment - 10% Discount

- Payment must be made by August 15th to ensure that the student can begin school on time. (The school calendar will be provided for clarity)
- K1 to Year 6 full time with discount = \$1620
- K1 and K2 part time with discount = \$864

Termly payment - 5% Discount

- 3 payments made before the beginning of each term. (August 15th, December 15th and March 15th).
- K1 to Year 6 full time with discount = \$570 per term.
- K1 and K2 part time with discount = \$288 per term.

Monthly payment

- Monthly payments must be made by the 1st day of each calendar month and not later than the 5th of each month.

Multiple Sibling Discount

- 5% discount for every child enrolled with or after the initial child.

- Yearly capital fee
- 1 uniform
- Morning snack
- All learning materials & resources

Payment Methods

- All payments must be made in US dollars (\$).
- Payments can be made in cash or online transfer using the details provided below.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Learning Tree is fully committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all students. All staff members are trained in First Aid by the Cambodian Red Cross, equipping them to respond appropriately in case of medical emergencies. We uphold a strong duty of care to every child in our care and take all reasonable steps to safeguard their physical and emotional well-being during school hours and on school premises.
2. All tuition and fees are due on the indicated dates. Failure to make payments within three (3) weeks will result in exclusion of your child from The Learning Tree. In the case of there being a waiting list for your child's class, the place will be given to the first child on that list.
3. Parents enrolling their child at The Learning Tree must commit to the full academic school year. The school hires teachers, allocates staffing, and makes financial commitments based on yearly enrolment numbers. If a student leaves before the end of the school year, the school must still honour teacher contracts and operational costs; therefore, early withdrawal does not reduce the financial obligation for the family.
4. Refunds on paid tuition will only be considered upon written request and will apply only to full terms not attended. No partial refunds will be issued for students who leave during a term.
5. Refunds on paid tuition will only be considered upon written request and apply only to full terms not attended. No partial refunds will be issued for students who leave during an ongoing term.

Tuition fee refunds are only applicable to students who are permanently withdrawn from The Learning Tree. Refunds will not be granted for temporary absences — such as

holidays or time away during the term — unless exceptional circumstances apply.

Exceptional circumstances may include:

- Permanent relocation to another country
- A student's terminal illness that prevents continued schooling

In such cases, parents must:

1. Submit a written refund request.
2. Attend a meeting with the School Director and School Manager.
3. Provide official proof or documentation (e.g., relocation papers, medical reports).

Fee Increases

Tuition fees are reviewed annually during the development of the budget and are subject to change. Parents will be notified at least 2 months before the start of the new school year if any changes have been implemented.
