## Season of Advent

Today we begin a new church year with the beginning of the holy season of Advent. In Advent the church prepares to celebrate the Nativity, when we recall Christ's first coming as the infant of Bethlehem. As we remember, so we also look forward in faith and hope to his second coming at the end of time. Advent is then a season of joyful hope and anticipation. This hope of Advent is expressed up to the 16th December as the liturgy concentrates on the Second Coming while the first coming is recalled from the 17th December, when Christ is seen as the fulfilment of the hope of Israel.
