## WHAT THE EVIDENCE IS SAYING



- Effective communication leads to a 72% <u>increase in productivity</u> among business leaders. (Mahajan, 2024)
- 66% of business leaders experience <u>some form of miscommunication</u> at least once a day. (Project. Co., 2023)
- 100% of business leaders and knowledge workers stated <u>experiencing</u>
   <u>miscommunication</u> at the workplace at least once a week. (Project. Co., 2024)
- 55% of people <u>communicate</u> with their clients <u>via email</u> in 2024. (Mahajan,2024)
- According to Grammarly's 2024 State of Business Communication report, the cost of miscommunication at the workplace cost US businesses \$1.2 trillion in 2022. 2023 was a rise in communication, while its effectiveness simultaneously declined. In 2024, however, AI has brought about new solutions and challenges that have forced businesses to focus on better and not more communication.
- A 2020 study found 85% of 150 people surveyed believed eye contact to be critical to business communication. (Philips, 1993)
- 82% of knowledge workers and 90% of business leaders state that <u>working remotely</u> increases their need to be a better communicator. (Mahajan, 2024)
- 21% of workers claim that remote work made communication somewhat difficult, and 6% found that it <u>made communication very difficult</u>. (Mahajan, 2024)
- With an increase in remote and hybrid work, businesses are increasingly <u>relying on</u> written communication, with an 18% increase year over year. (Project. Co., 2024)
