Any high school class of 2023 senior is invited to compete for this one-time scholarship. The award may be used to help defray the costs of any accredited, post-secondary educational institution during the 2023-2024 academic years.

Enclosed are application materials needed to apply for these scholarships. The application deadline is March 31, 2023. Only complete applications with the appropriate materials attached will be reviewed.

Materials required:

- Applicant's "Scholarship Cover Page" (attached)
- "Honors and Awards" (attached)- limited to 10 entries only
- "Leadership, Volunteer service involvement, extracurricular activities, outside employment" (attached)-limited to 10 entries only
- Academic Rigor (attached)- Include transcripts for Dual Enrollment Courses
- 250-300 word essay on the following topic: ***What do you hope/intend to leave as a legacy when your time on this Earth is complete?***
- High School transcript (including schedule for the final semester).

Applicants will be judged and rated by the following:

1. Honors and Awards
2. Leadership, Community, Volunteer Service (outside school hours). Extracurricular activities, outside employment
3. Academic Rigor
4. Academic Performance
5. Essay (content, length, format, grammar/spelling)

For winners to receive their awards, they must provide official verification of attendance for the fall 2023 semester enrollment at an accredited, post-secondary educational institution by September 24, 2023. Award checks will be mailed as soon as possible after verification has been received, made payable to the post-secondary institution the student is attending.

The deadline for submission of all application materials is **March 31, 2023**. All application materials must be postmarked by **March 31, 2023**.
