CNA Testing Resource Guide

Congratulations on completing your CNA program! Below are resources and testing locations to help you take the next step in becoming a Certified Nursing Assistant in California.

State Competency Exam Information

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) requires all CNA candidates to pass a written and skills competency examination to become certified. The exam is administered by Pearson VUE or its partner agencies.

- Exam Components:
 1. Written Exam: 70 multiple-choice questions.
 2. Skills Test: Demonstration of five randomly selected nursing assistant skills.

How to Schedule Your Exam

1. Obtain an Application:

Complete the Initial Application for CNA Certification on the CDPH website: CDPH Licensing and Certification.

2. Register for Testing:

Visit the Pearson VUE CNA Testing portal to register and schedule your exam: Pearson VUE CNA Testing.

3. Pay Exam Fees:
 - Written & Skills Exam: \$120
 - Retest Fees:
 - Written Only: \$35
 - Skills Only: \$85
