Community Rule #7: No Parking on Street

"No owner, family member, guest of the owner, or tenant may have his or her <u>vehicle parked in any of</u> <u>the streets or sidewalks</u> of the community <u>overnight or for a prolonged</u> period of time."

- This rule was adopted as requested by the Scottsdale Fire Department because our community's private streets are 15 feet narrower than the required 40 feet width of regular city streets. Due to the fact that parking may interfere with the functions of emergency vehicles, Adobe Ranch Villas has banned overnight parking and/or prolonged daytime parking of motor vehicles upon the streets and sidewalks.
- Noncompliance with this rule may result in a daily monetary penalty ranging from \$10.00 to \$500.00 per day or towing of your vehicle.
- If you are unable to park your vehicle in your garage or driveway, please park on the west side of 114th Street.

Towing of Vehicles Parked on the Street

A warning notice will be placed on cars which park overnight, for prolonged periods of time during the day/night, or cars which repeatedly park on the street. After receiving a warning on your car, the vehicle will be towed. Since it is an HOA rule and a Scottsdale Fire safety issue to not have cars parked on our streets, the Association has contracted with a towing company: All Valley Impound.

- If your vehicle is towed, please contact All Valley Impound at 602-278-1600.
- All expenses related to towing and retrieval of the vehicle will be at the owner's expense.
