## **Community Rule #7:**

"No owner, family member, guest of the owner, or tenant may have his or her vehicle parked in any of the streets or sidewalks of the community overnight or for a prolonged period of time."

- the Scottsdale Fire Department because our community's private streets are 15 feet narrower than the required 40 feet width of regular city streets. Due to the fact that parking may interfere with the functions of emergency vehicles, Adobe Ranch Villas has banned overnight parking and/or prolonged daytime parking of motor vehicles upon the streets and sidewalks.
- Noncompliance with this rule may result in a daily monetary penalty ranging from \$10.00 to \$500.00 per day or towing of your vehicle.

# Adobe Ranch Villa Pool and Spa Community Area

As homeowners and residents, it is important to maintain a clean and safe pool and spa environment. Our pool is a semi-private pool, and is often inspected by the Environmental Health Division. They can close our pool immediately for any violations. By following the posted rules in the pool area as well as the rules listed below, we should have a pool and spa that we can enjoy all year around!!

- Please become aware of all posted rules in and around the pool and spa area.
- No Lifeguard on duty! All persons visit the pool at his/her own risk.
- The **Pool gate must remain CLOSED and LATCHED at all times**. Make sure the gate to the pool is ALWAYS completely shut. Do NOT prop the door open. Whenever you enter or exit the pool area, be sure the pool gate completely closes and latches shut.
- **Pool Hours**: Sunday Thursday 7:00 AM 10:00 PM Friday and Saturday 7:00 AM 11:00 PM
- Anyone under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- **Do NOT bring any glassware** (bottles, glasses, cups, etc.) into the pool area <u>or</u> <u>even throw them away in the pool trash can.</u> (City pool inspectors will shut down the pool even if there is glass in the trash can!) Any drinks brought to the pool area should be in **non-breakable containers**.
- No drinks, candy, tobacco, popcorn, gum, alcohol, or food of any kind are permitted in the pool or within 4 feet from the edge of the pool.
- Make sure **all pool furniture is at least 4 feet from the pool edge.** If you move the pool furniture while at the pool, please move it back before you leave.
- No animals are allowed (except for official service animals).
- Owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
- The Board of Directors reserves the right to deny use of pool or spa to anyone or close the pool and spa at anytime.
