New Solar Market Development Tax Credit (NSMDTC)	State	10% of solar PV/thermal costs (up to \$6K residential/\$60K commercial); 10-year carryforward. Applies to data center integration.	Systems 2020-2031; EMNRD-certified. Luna/Grant eligible.
Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) Grants/Loans	Federal (USDA)	Up to 50% grants + 75% loan guarantees for renewables (e.g., rural data center solar); \$145M national FY2025.	Rural businesses (Luna/Grant qualify); zero-emission priority. No grants July-Sept 2025.
Grid Modernization Grant Program	State	Up to \$70M (2025) for renewables/storage integration (e.g., data center microgrids), funds pilots/infrastructure.	Reliability/resilience focus; utilities in Luna/Grant. Rolling monthly from Nov 2025.
Industrial Revenue Bonds (IRBs) for Renewables	County	Bonds for solar/wind, equipment tax abatements.	Commercial/utility-scale; job-creating.
Solar for All Grant	State/ Federal (EPA)	\$156M for low-income/community solar, supports off-site renewables for data centers. Launch late 2025.	Underserved areas like Luna/Grant; pairs with rooftop/community systems.
Net Metering & REC Programs	Utility/ State	Grid credits for excess renewables; utility REC buys	Up to 10 MW systems; net metering active, RECs vary.

Other Incentives

Incentive Program	Level	Description	Eligibility / Notes
Industrial Revenue Bonds (IRBs)	County	Tax-exempt bonds financing construction/equipment; up to 30-year property tax abatements and gross receipts exemptions. Used for data centers (e.g., \$165B for Project Jupiter).	Job-creating projects (e.g., 750+ roles at \$75K+ salary); available via Luna/Grant commissions. Approvals in 2-4 weeks.
Local Economic Development Act (LEDA) Grants	State	Discretionary infrastructure grants (e.g., utilities/roads) for business attraction; up to \$10M/project.	Aligns with county plans; job/capital investment focus. Reimbursement-based; statewide including Luna/Grant.
Job Training Incentive Program (JTIP)	State	Reimburses 50-75% of training costs for new jobs (up to \$50K/trainee; e.g., \$1.6M/year for Meta).	New hires in data centers; FY2025 supported 1,238 jobs statewide at \$25.28 avg. wage.
