We placed three "Shuubirds" in front of our lunch break area chairs and the Geese that are normally there have disappeared. Matt D.

GOLF COURSES / GEESE

RHODE ISLAND / GOLF COURSE

We placed 12 “Shuubirds” on our golf course to deter Geese from grouping up and leaving large Geese droppings on the fairway next to the ponds. The migratory Geese have left, and the resident Geese have moved to the neighbor’s property. All because of the “Shuubirds”.

ATLANTA GOLF COURSE

A friend deployed 10 “Shuubirds” at golf course’s request to deter Geese and 100% of Geese gone and no more “Shuubirds” needed when follow-up call made.

CONYERS, GEORGIA / GOLF COURSE

Golf course remain status quo pending the approval for Geese removal from the State of Georgia. I (Shuubird rep.) visited the site and the Geese that remain were away from the green, away from the “Shuubirds” and congregated at the far end of the pond. Dennis P.

McDONOUGH, GEORGIA / GOLF COURSE

We started a month ago (7/25) with 60 Geese counted on the first visit. An initial deployment of 15 “Shuubirds” resulted in positive feedback from course manager. I went back today made and assessment of the other areas. Deployed 40 “Shuubirds” and ALL the Geese have left the property. Management reports in the early mornings the Geese fly over the course, but NONE land at the course. SUPER RESULTS. Dennis P.

COVINGTON, GEORGIA / GOLF COURSE

This golf course continues to improve. The initial deployment of 30 “Shuubirds” on 07/21 resulted in positive feedback a week later with the number of Geese on the back half of the course disappearing. I went out this Monday and met with the new grounds superintendent and we discussed his view of the program, his assessment of the “Shuubirds” and plans to continue or not. He was acceptable to what we had going on and pointed out an area that was negatively impacting golfers as Geese moved from previous areas to this one area. I told him that is a good thing and if I can get them out of this area, problem solved. I went this morning and deployed 15 “Shuubirds” to abate the issue. While there, 4 different golfers stopped and gave positive feedback on the impact the “Shuubirds” were having on keeping the greens free from droppings. GREAT news... I will follow up next week and my goal is to hear the Geese have left the area. Dennis P.
