Some projects require special skills and others just need strong backs or willing hands. The list below shows the projects we need help with by type.

Please know that some bigger projects can be divided over several days and into several teams. On the other hand, if you would like to adopt a home, we can get you a different list that shows all the repair needs each homeowner has.

Anna (Senior woman)**

1. Replace insulated glass pane in wooden window sash.**
2. Repair back storm door (handle and screen)*

Betty (Senior disabled woman)**

1. Replace guts in two toilets* *

Cynthia (Senior disabled woman)*

1. Scrape and paint the exterior of the home. (lead-based paint; will supply PPE)*

Gail (Senior Woman)**

1. Replace two pieces of siding**
2. Repair pvc handrail at back steps***
3. Stretch carpet* *
4. Tighten the metal trim on the porch column*

Gary (Disabled Man)**

1. Replace one missing corbel on the back roof overhang**
2. Replace about 20' of wood fascia on the side of the house**
3. Repair/replace rotting front porch columns**

Geneva (Senior woman)*/**

1. Fill in the hole at the exterior foundation (about 2'x2'x2') and tamp.*
2. Scrape and paint soffit and fascia boards*
3. Replace a few ceiling tiles in the dining room* *
4. **Inspect/replace non-functioning receptacles in the den****

Henrietta (Senior woman)**

1. Inspect and patch roof leak (kitchen and above)**
2. Replace a 6'x6' sections of subfloor in the den and underneath the washing machine**

Jennifer (Disabled woman)**

1. Re-anchor the handrail at the front porch*
2. Replace approximately 16' plywood soffit and fascia **
3. **Inspect non-functioning HVAC*****
4. **Replace leaking hose bib with freezeproof sillcock ****

Lettie (Senior woman)**

1. Repair crack in textured ceiling approx.. 12ft long**
2. Repair the bathroom ceiling where the textured layer is peeling**
3. Bedroom 1- KILZ water spot on the ceiling, then paint*
4. Bedroom 2- The ceiling register has fallen* *
5. Install storm door handles at the front and the back doors**

Lisa (Disabled woman)*

1. Clean and paint the bathroom*

Mary (Senior woman)*

1. Scrape and paint the front porch, including the ceiling*
2. Scrape and paint the back porch, including the ceiling*
(Paint MAY contain lead. Will provide PPE)

Pamela (Senior woman)**

1. Remove approximately 150SF of vinyl and a layer of Sureply board**
2. Install new underlayment and new vinyl or LVP***

Regina (Senior woman)*

1. Rebuild wooden gate* *
2. Fill in small water feature "pond" with dirt to eliminate trip hazard*

Roy (Senior man)**

1. Replace wooden windowsill in double LR window**
2. Replace the back door with pre-hung steel door*
3. Install metal ring at water heater vent pipe at ceiling**
4. Replace 12 pieces of lap siding***
5. Unclog the tub drain* *

Sylvia (Senior woman)

1. Fasten about 3' of loose paneling above the kitchen cabinets*
2. Repair ceiling drywall in the bathroom**
3. Install a grab bar in the shower* *
4. KILZ and paint the office ceiling*
5. Install handrails for the back steps* *

Taronica (Disabled woman)

1. Install floor register*
2. Repair weak spots in the kitchen floor***

Tatrisse and David (Senior couple)**

1. Scrape/glaze/paint windows**
2. Make sure the bath fan vents outside properly* *

Tomica (Low Income)

1. Water spots on ceilings (multiple rooms)
2. Cabinets in kitchen
3. Swap thermostat
4. Re attach ductwork

Linda (low-income woman)

1. LVP in hallway

Charlotte (Low-income woman)

1. Rehab several windows, scrape and paint sills on several. Add storms to several windows.
2. Doors
3. Gutters

Jason (Disabled male)

1. Water heater
2. Disconnect the yard light in the front yard.

Fernandez (Disabled male)

1. Assess and repair: Breaker keeps tripping, receptacles at counter not all working.
2. Assess the floor under the toilet, tub/shower faucet. Open wall to assess. PAN staff assist.

LaTonya (Low-income woman)

1. Door replacement
2. Painting
3. Drywall repair

Adonnus (Elderly woman)

1. Clean up exterior on porch, remove bird nest/debris.
2. Replace shingles, center part of right gable with Hardie or Perfection shingles.

Carolyn (Elderly woman)

1. Door/Door frame
2. Replace the faucet in the front bath, drain house wrap under house that is holding water, identify and repair the leak.
