RULES & REGULATIONS 2024 for CCCAHA OPEN BREED HORSE SHOWS CCCAHA or USEF RULES WILL APPLY

- 1. Safety of Participants, their horses and observers will be put first in all situations.
 - a. ASTM Certified helmets with harness/chin strap are recommended for all classes, but Western and Ranch Riding riders may wear a Western style hat at their own risk. Boots are required for all classes.
 - b. Safety stirrups will be allowed.
- 2. JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL
- 3. Show Management reserves the right to combine or divide any classes.
- 4. **APPROPRIATE** attire should be worn by all participants including **HALTER DIVISION**. **Western and Ranch Riding Division** riders may wear a Western Style hat, but helmets are recommended. Long sleeve shirts or jackets, long pants and Western boots. Riding chaps may be worn for Western and Ranch Riding competition. **English Division** riders must wear approved helmets, boots, breeches, long sleeve shirt with vest or jacket, (short sleeve shirts may be worn underneath jacket), ties or stock ties. In the event that Judge calls coats due to heat, short sleeve shirts may be worn without ties or stock ties. If you are a coach or a trainer, you must also adhere to the same rules regarding tack and safety gear while in the main, trail or ranch arena. No Unmounted riders are allowed in any competition arena unless the class is **Halter**, **Showmanship or Lead Line**.
- 5. **AWARDS** for High Point of the Day and all **YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS** will be awarded only to Riders showing their own horses. **Open Riders or Trainers** riding a student's or client's horse will **not** be allowed to compete for Day End or Year End High Point Awards.
- 6. Horses should also be in appropriate tack for the division entered. English Division require English, Hunt Seat or Dressage style saddle with USEF approved English tack. Western Division requires Western style or modified Western style (pommel instead of horn) saddle with curb bit and neck reins. Exceptions: Horses 5 years old and under may be ridden with a Snaffle bit (or Bosal in Western and Ranch Riding classes) & may be ridden with direct reins instead of neck reins. Ranch Riding Division tack should be workman like with no special adornments. No Training Devices of any kind will be allowed in any class. This includes leg supports and Martingales of any type. Consult the USEF rules for more information about training devices.
- 7. **Warm Up** of horses MUST BE in designated warm up area. No horses will be allowed to warm up in common areas frequented by pedestrians.
- 8. Lead Line Division requires an adult 18 years or older to handle horse.
- 9. Lead Line Division riders may NOT cross enter into any other riding division
- 10. Walk/Trot 11 & Under Division riders may NOT cross enter into any other division
- 11. Walk/Trot 12 & Over Division riders may NOT cross enter into any other division
- 12. Walk/Trot riders MAY enter a second horse in ANY other division including Walk/Trot
- 13. Stallions may only be shown by handlers 18 years of age and older.
- 14. The **TWO MINUTE** gate rule will be enforced. Tack changes may be granted if rider or representative requests a tack change no later than TWO (2) classes prior to the class. Tack Change equals 5 minutes or the rider is disqualified from class.
- 15. There will be NO CLASS ADDITIONS DURING THE SHOW. NO REFUNDS of fees without an Authorized Veterinarian Certificate.
- 16. ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS due to liability insurance issues.
- 17. All children under the age of 18 must be under adult supervision at all times.
- 18. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 5th place to the rider (except Arabian Division).
- 19. Buckle Series Competitors MUST be an active CCCAHA (Adult) or AHA (Adult/Youth) member in good standing at registration for Buckle Series AND must compete in at least 2 of the 3 shows to qualify for Buckle Series
- 20. Day End High Point winners will be awarded in each division.
- 21. ALL ENTRIES ARE DUE BY 5:00 PM TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE SHOW AND MUST BE PREPAID. Entries must be completely filled out LEGIBLY and correctly with ALL DECLARED DIVISIONS noted (we can't read your minds so if no division is declared, no division is awarded). ANY INCOMPLETE ENTRIES may be rejected. This includes proper SIGNATURE and date on the entry form. No fees will be allowed to be paid on the day of the show. The Entry Form is also our LIABILITY RELEASE FORM and must be signed to be considered acknowledged.
