NARRATOR: A tiny village. A lonely stable. No one suspected that God was able. But, He was. And, He used ordinary people to fulfill the promise of Isaiah. Mary, the mother of Jesus, no doubt grew up in a humble home. The bible tells us she was "highly favored" and "blessed of God." Mary and her sister had always been close and were very devoted to each other. So, we begin here... (*#2) with two sisters, grateful they have each other to depend upon.

SONG # 2 – CLOSER THAN KIN TO ME (MARY AND HER SISTER)

NARRATOR: Mary and Joseph took their betrothal very seriously. It meant that they were engaged, promised and legally bound to each other. Like any couple in love, they no doubt had hopes and dreams of the wonderful life they would have together. What better place to envision the future than under a starry sky (*#3) where they could thank God for the beauty of the moment and for the perfect love they shared.

SONG #3 HEAVEN CAME DOWN (MARY AND JOSEPH)

BOTH: Tonight, when Heaven came down,_____Heaven came down.

NARRATOR: While Mary was alone, she was visited by the Angel Gabriel. (*#4) She was no doubt troubled and confused. Mary learned from Gabriel that she had been chosen to bear the Son of the Most High God.

SONG #4 GABRIEL'S GREETING (GABRIEL)

GABRIEL: Greetings and Salutations! Oh Mary, congratulations!

> I am an angel, Mary; God sent me here. My name is Gabriel; no need to fear.

God is with you. Blessed are you among women;

Honored and most highly favored. Don't be afraid, Mary; anointed one.

For God has chosen you to bear His Son: Our Messiah,

Jesus Christ, the Lord; the Son of God!

NARRATOR: Gabriel told Mary that her son would be the Savior of the world...the Messiah. He reminded her that the prophet Isaiah had written, "...Behold a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and give Him the name Immanuel, which means, 'God is with us.' The Holy Spirit shall come upon you, and the power of God shall overshadow you. That is why this baby born to you will be completely holy. He will be the Son of the Most High God, for

nothing is impossible with God."

Confused, Mary knew she had to tell her parents. This was going to be one of the hardest things she had ever done. Worried about their reaction, Mary may have gone to her mother, Anna first. Needless to say, he was confused and full of questions. (*#6)

SONG # 6 – MARY, WHY? (JOSEPH)

NARRATOR: Before long Mary also had to tell her father, Joachim about the visit from Gabriel. Like Joseph, he too must have wondered how such news could be true. He knew the scriptures well but must have questioned how it could be that his daughter was in fact the chosen one. Joachim, his wife, Anna, Joseph and Mary spent agonizing hours praying for answers. (*#7)

SONG # 7 - IN GOD'S HANDS (JOACHIM, ANNA, JOSEPH AND MARY)

JOACHIM: Right from the start she had my heart.

Once our eyes met, my life was set:

It's hard to let go, when I love her so! I've tried and tried to figure out what I did wrong. I never dreamed a problem like this would come along. I just can't see, and I don't understand, So it has to be in God's hands. (key change) **JOAC/ANNA/JOS/MARY:** I can't believe this is happening to me! What I've been told is an impossibility! And yes, I pray, but I don't understand, So this must stay in God's hands; in God's hands; It's in God's hands.

NARRATOR: When Mary was visited by the Angel Gabriel, he *also* said to her, "Even now, Zechariah and Elizabeth are rejoicing in God, for they too are expecting a son, a child anointed of God who will prepare the way for Jesus, the Messiah...the baby you now carry in your womb. Go to her, Mary. For the child she now carries lies dormant, awaiting a touch from the Holy Spirit. At the sound of your voice, the baby in her womb will leap for joy in the presence of God's Son. Do not tarry; go to her, Mary."

> Like Joseph, Mary's father, Joachim also likely needed time alone to pray and learn to accept that God had chosen Mary to become the mother of His Son. So, Mary, her sister and her mother traveled together to visit Elizabeth and Zechariah. When Elizabeth heard Mary's voice, the infant she was carrying leapt in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out and said, "Most blessed are you among women, Mary, (*#8) and blessed is the fruit of your womb."

NARRATOR: Still full of doubt, Joseph needed a sign from God (*#9) to help him accept the fact that Mary, his betrothed was in fact carrying the Son of God. One restless night while Joseph slept, an angel appeared to him.

SONG #9 – JOSEPH'S DREAM (GABRIEL)

GABRIEL: Joseph, Joseph, don't hesitate; don't make her wait;

Mary's been true, faithful to you; for this is God's plan for

your life.

This baby was conceived by the Holy Ghost.
