Naturally, Noah and Huldah are still the major characters in this new script. Shem, Ham, Japheth, and their wives have also been added to many of the songs previously only sung by Noah and Huldah.

Throughout the script an (*#) indicates approximately where the sound track begins for each song/sound cue. The exact cue number appears inside the parentheses as well.

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HULDAH:

(Comes down aisle through audience while talking, then goes to SR table.) You probably don't know much about me, but I tell you, I had to put up with quite a few things in those days! Noah can be pretty bullheaded at times and work too hard. And, I usually get the brunt end of it all! Yes, you guessed it; I'm Noah's wife, Huldah...which means "weasel." So, it's no wonder my name didn't go down in history like Noah's! You know, it was quite a sight to see the day Noah and our sons started to build the ark. I tell you, if it weren't for the grace of God and the help of our three boys, Noah would be a nervous wreck by now! Shem was a great help keeping peace and order around here. And Ham always was a good worker like his father. Why, even Japheth, our youngest son, worked hard. Oh, here I am bragging about (*#1) my boys when I really ought to be getting on with my story. Perhaps I should explain a few things to you first...

SONG # 1 - NOAH AND THE FLOOD Huldah and Noah

HULDAH: Have you heard about Noah and the flood,

How the rain poured down and turned the earth to mud?

The Lord said, "Noah, an ark you should build." And it turned out bigger than a football field! (Noah enters also coming down the aisle.)

BOTH: You see the ark was a boat that was made to float,

Many, many days on the sea.

God destroyed the world of sin, but protected us within.

And He gave us a new life and set us free!

(Interlude)

BOTH: Now you'll hear about Noah and the flood,

How God stopped sin and nipped it in the bud! The Lord protected Noah and his whole family. Now listen to the story of their life upon the sea.

And maybe you will hear what God can do for you and me!

(Sound track continues to play out as underscore until it fades - then OFF.)

HULDAH:

I'll never forget the night Noah called the boys into our tent. Noah told them all about what the Lord asked him to do. They all sat so still and listened. They knew Noah was a just and righteous man and they believed his every word. They knew that God had spoken to their father and that now they too must help build the ark the Lord said to build. You see, the world had gotten so wicked and full of evil that God decided to send a flood to destroy every living thing on the earth. (HULDAH chuckles.) I remember the boys got a little nervous when Noah mentioned the flood. But Noah reminded them that the Lord God promised to take care of us because our family had always loved and trusted Him. Noah was very honored that God would choose him (*#2) to carry out this plan.

SONG # 2 - RIGHTEOUS AND TRUE Huldah and Noah

HULDAH: For Noah was righteous. He was a good, good, man.

And Noah was truthful; the only one in the land. Noah, chosen of God, to take this trip abroad;

BOTH: To gather the animals two by two,

And travel with them in a floating zoo. True - oo - oo - blue!

BOTH: For Noah was righteous. He was a good, good, man.

And Noah was truthful; the only one in the land.

HULDAH: God needed a man,
NOAH: (Shouts) That's me!!
HULDAH: To carry out His plan.

BOTH: So He searched in all the Land,

And found that Noah would lend a hand. True - oo - oo - blue!!

BOTH: For God chose Noah. God chose Noah.

Righteous and true - woo-woo-woo!!

(Sound track continues to play out as underscore until it fades - then OFF.)

HULDAH: Noah, what you need is a good night's sleep; now off to bed with you! One "Ham" in the family is enough!! (NOAH goes off to bed, SL; HULDAH goes to her SR table. NOAH quickly settles and goes to sleep.) The next morning Noah woke at daybreak, rarin' to go!

(Sound effect (*#3): rooster crowing two times.)

NOAH: (Yawns very loudly.) What a glorious day to begin work on the ark. Huldah,

I'll need a hearty breakfast this morning. I want to chop down as many

trees as possible before dark.

HULDAH: You'd better holler at the boys to get up Noah. They'll need to get the oxen

ready for work.

NOAH: Shem! Ham! Ja-a-pheth!! It's time to get up boys. We've got lots of work to

do. (To HULDAH.) I'll be back before dark, my dear. (SHEM, HAM, and JAPHEPH enter with their wives. Each wife gives her husband a wrapped parcel for his lunch later that day. The sons follow NOAH. The wives join HULDAH and begin various chores: sewing, cleaning, preparing food, etc.)

HULDAH: Week after week they continued to work hard cutting down trees. I was

forever sending the boys' wives out with more food. They would build up such an appetite working like that. Finally, after months and months of chopping, (*#4) they had enough wood to start building the ark! (HULDAH

hands NOAH a pack of food.)

SONG #3 - POUNDING AND HAMM'RING Noah and Sons

NOAH: Pounding and hamm'ring all day.
SONS: One by one...not much fun!
NOAH: Building the ark the Lord's way.
SONS: When it's done, it's just begun!
SONS: Sawing and measuring logs.
NOAH: Short ones here...long to the rear!

SONS: Working as hard as a dog.

ALL: The end I fear is not very near! (NOAH hits his thumb and yells, "OUCH!!")

(4 measures of music; NOAH and SONS ad lib.)

ALL: Four hundred fifty feet long, three stories high...my, oh my!

It's safe and sturdy and strong.

NOAH: To finish I must really try.

ALL: To finish I must really try. I'll try.

(Sound track continues to play out as underscore until it fades - then OFF.)

HULDAH: Years passed as they continued to work hard on the ark. I could hardly get

Noah to stop for a break. He was at it from dawn till dusk, and *that's* a miracle considering Noah was nearly 600 years old! (NOAH looks up at the

audience.) Of course, he didn't look a day over 400!! (NOAH smiles

broadly, very pleased with himself.) He holds his age well. Now, you can

imagine the snide remarks and laughter heard from all the people.

ANNA: It seemed *everybody* knew what was going on at our place.

BERNICE: They all thought Noah was really off his rocker this time!! (HULDAH gives

her a reprimanding look.) Oops...sorry...

HULDAH: It would hurt me to see Noah so sad, when time after time he would warn

the people to turn from their wicked ways and believe in God. But they

would only laugh in his face and refuse to listen and believe.

PHOEBE: And the neighbors, well, they were just plain nasty about it. Why, you

should hear (*#5) the things that they were saying...!

SHEM: Oh no...here come those nasty neighbors again...!

SONG # 4 - KNOCKIN' NOAH RAP Nasty Neighbors

(May be rapped live by the Nasty Neighbors. Or, NOAH and his family may pretend that the Neighbors are "out there" by playing the rap track from the accompaniment sound track. Either way, NOAH has a hard time constraining HULDAH during the rap. At one point she rolls up her sleeves and marches past NOAH, who grabs her and pulls her back.)

NEIGHBORS: Hey, Noah! What-cha buildin'? Don't ya think it's kinda big?

From the looks of it I'd say that you had really flipped your wig!

All this talk about a boat when we've yet to see it rain.

Guess the neighbors were all right when they said you were insane! Have you really lost your marbles to believe that God would say,

To build a boat, then preach to us to change our wicked ways?

Are you dumb enough to think that all your neighbors will believe,

That God told you to load the animals by twos then leave? Go build your silly boat, Noah, and maybe if you're lucky.

We'll all chip in to buy for you your own rubber ducky! (Ha, Ha, Ha.)

(Laughter on the sound track plays out then track is turned OFF)

HULDAH: In spite of the sneers and jeers, Noah and the boys kept at it. Boy, I have to

hand it to them; I don't know how they put up with those snide remarks. Why, if it were me and the boy's wives we probably would've tarred n'

feathered 'em and knocked their heads together and...

NOAH: (Interrupting HULDAH.) Ahem!

HULDAH: I guess that's why God told Noah to build the ark and not me! (Chuckles.)

ANNA: Time seemed to fly by and each day the ark looked better and better.

BERNICE: Of course, it's not exactly what *I'd* choose to live in, (*Gets another*

reprimanding look from HULDAH.) but...it wasn't bad. In fact, it looked

pretty good... (Aside so HULDAH doesn't hear.) for an ark, mind you!!

(HULDAH does a double take at BERNICE'S comment.)

HAM: Well, it's finally starting to look like a boat.

SHEM: It shouldn't be too much longer and we'll be done.

JAPHETH: (Looks pleadingly at the women like he may faint at any moment and winks

at NOAH.) But...we'll need to keep up our strength to finish...

NOAH: (Getting the hint, he responds to JAPHETH.) Oh...right! (Then turns to his

wife.) Uh...Huldah, dear...we could use some more food you know. You wouldn't want us passing out up on the deck now, would you? (*#6)

(HULDAH hands NOAH a rubber chicken. The wives follow suit, handing their husbands various strange food items. NOAH and his sons are downcast at first, but they become more jovial as the tempo picks up and they get back to work.)

SONG #5 - POUNDING AND HAMM'RING (Reprise) Noah and Sons

NOAH: "Build me an ark." the Lord said. Yes, I heard every word.

This wasn't just in my head. It's not absurd! I heard His word!

SHEM: I'll put pitch all over this ship!
HAM/JAPH: We'll make stalls, wide and tall.
ALL: We're gonna have a great trip!

NOAH: The wicked fall; I'll make them crawl!! (Gets a look from the others so he

shouts out.) Just kidding!!

ALL: All in all...we'll have a ball!

When God calls...we give Him all! Give all! Give all!

(Track OFF when accompaniment finishes.)

(If a set is used the ark is "revealed" or set into place during the last lines of the song.)

HULDAH: At last the day arrived...the ark...

WIVES: Is finished!! (HULDAH jumps from their outburst, but definitely agrees.)

HAM: Well, what do you think?

SHEM: Not bad, huh?

JAPHETH: God has been so faithful in helping us finish this great task.

NOAH: I'm sure that He's pleased with our work. Now, if only the people would

listen to me and turn from their sin, they might be saved. But, it saddens

me so when they only laugh and walk away.

HULDAH: I know, but you can only do so much, Noah. I doubt if God Himself could

get them to repent; their hearts are like stone!!

NOAH: Huldah!! (Gives her a stern look!)

HULDAH: (Quickly changing the subject.) We must remember to thank the Lord for

taking care of us and our family. He has been so good to us, Noah...

NOAH: Yes He has; Praise His name! Now, have you and the girls finished

storing food and supplies inside the ark?

HULDAH: It is perfect timing, Noah!

ANNA: We've just finished loading the ark with everything we'll need for the trip.

PHOEBE: Now all that's left is to load the animals...

BERNICE: (*Grimaces.*) ... And I'm not looking forward to *that!*

HULDAH: (Rolls her eyes at BERNICE.) Do you even know what to bring, Noah?
