Directions to Hike:

5197 Silver Dr., Wooster, OH 44691

Carpooling is encouraged as parking can be limited.

Go north on I-71 to Route 30 (exit 176). Take Route 30 east toward Wooster. Watch for the sign that says, "Entering Wayne County." From the Wayne County line, you will go about 5.6 miles and turn left (north) on County Road 157 (Jefferson Road). You will cross Old Lincoln Way at the first stop sign. At the second stop sign you will cross Route 250. Turn left at the stop sign where County Road 157 (Jefferson Road) ends and the parking lot for Wooster Memorial Park will be immediately on the right.

Hike Description:

The hike is approximately five miles. Most of the hike will be through woodlands. The hike has varied terrain, which includes several hills of short duration. There are pit latrines, picnic tables, and a shelter at the park.

Water, hiking poles, hat and bug spray
