Directions to Hike:

4405 Dillon Hills Drive, Nashport, OH 43830. [Dillon State Park Camp Store \(740\) 453-0442](#) This is the address of the Dillon Camp Store. In the park where Clay Littick Road meets Dillon Hills Dr. fork left onto Dillon Hills Dr. Follow Dillon Hills Dr. a little over a mile then turn right into the entrance with a big sign saying "Campstore/Campground". You will see a very large parking lot on the left. Park in this lot close to the Camp Store. Restrooms are available at the Camp Store. DO NOT follow the signs for the beach or ranger station or any other Dillon address.

Hike Description:

We will follow the Licking Bend Trail which is a well-used single file path through forest. It follows ravines and lake. The trail has numerous often rocky ups and downs and occasional steep but short hills. It can be muddy after rain especially where it intersects with horse trails. There is a short unavoidable stretch of tall grass. Plan on the hike taking 3.5 to 4.5 hours.
