### **Directions to Hike (Round Trip Distance 000 Miles):**

5172 Jackson Pike, Grove City 43123. From I-71 South, take exit 100, Stringtown Rd. Go east about 1.3 miles. Turn right on SR 104/Jackson Pike. Entrance is 1.4 miles on the left. Once in the park, drive to the roundabout and take the road to the right to the parking lots and restroom by the playground. Meet left of the restroom in the shade of the picnic area.

### **Hike Description:**

The trail along the Scioto River is scenic, shady and in the woods. However, the other trail could be sunny that leads to shady observation decks overlooking beautiful wooded ravines and floodplain. The trails are mostly flat with gravel and dirt, but there are two or three short hills to climb. We will hike to the new suspension bridge, but crossing it will be optional.

### **Suggested Items to Bring:**

Water, hiking stick, bug spray, sunscreen and hiking shoes (the trails *can* be muddy even in July). Dress for the weather.

### **Dinner Location and Directions:**

Olive Garden, 1514 Stringtown Rd., Grove City 43123, (614-277-4374). From the park turn right. Travel 1.4 miles and turn left on Stringtown. Travel about .6 mile. See Olive Garden on right and turn right onto Buckeye Pkwy to reach the restaurant entrance.
