

Boch Hollow **State Nature Preserve**

Miles: 5 Level: 3 ([level guide](#))

Directions to Hike:

Boch Hollow West Trailhead 7100 SR-664 Logan, OH 43138 - Take US-33 and drive southeast to SR-664, but **turn north** instead of heading south to Old Man's Cave. Take SR-664 north for 7 miles. You will park at the West Trailhead on the right side of the road (see map & photos on back). If you pass Zwickle Road, you overshot the parking lot by 0.5 miles.

Note: There are no restrooms at the preserve; however, there are rest areas on US-33 just before the SR-664 intersection and fast-food restaurants at the intersection.

Hike Description:

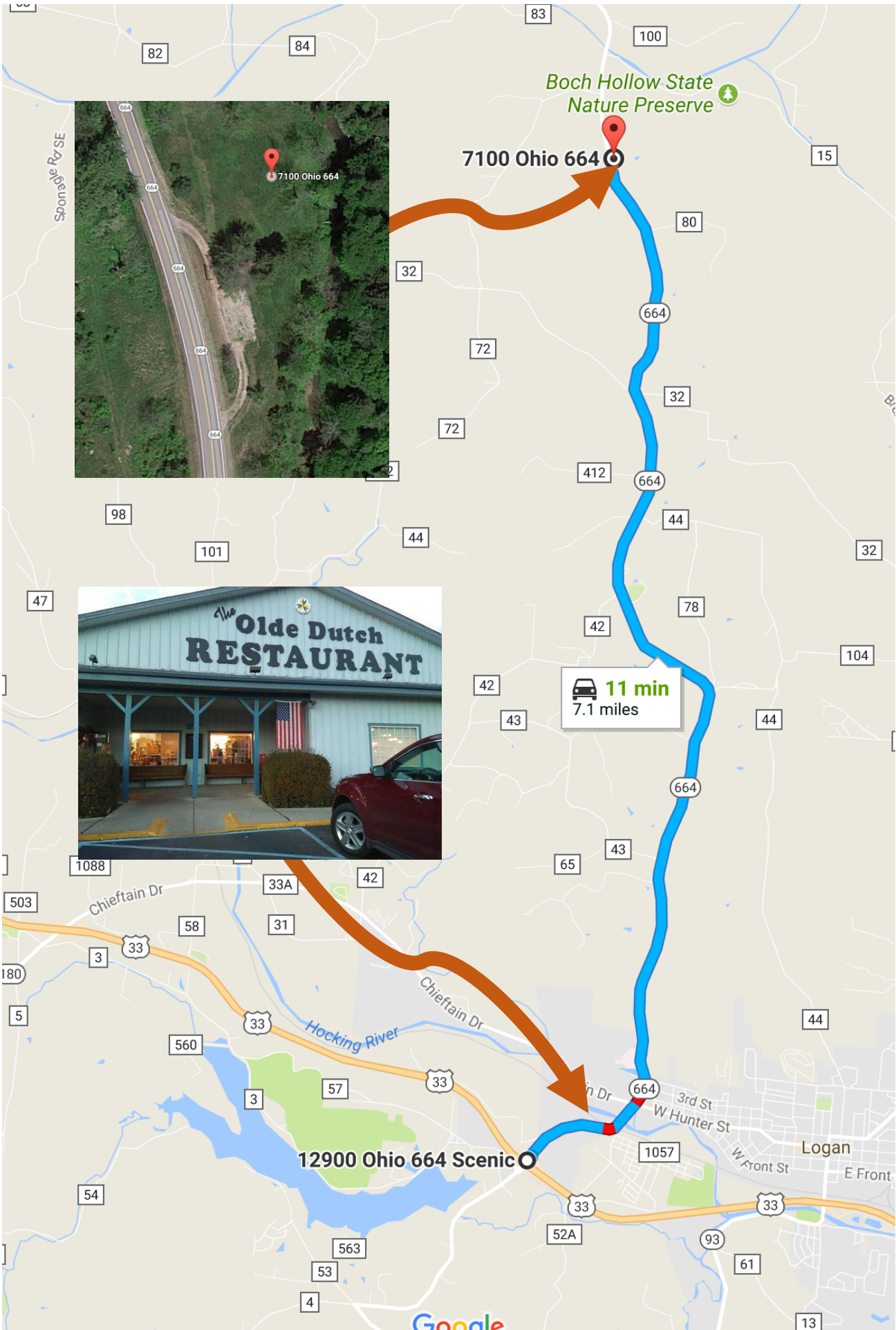
We will hike 4.2 miles mostly on the Buckeye Trail. The trails are mostly shaded through several habitats, including riparian corridors, ridges, and mature wooded hills with hemlocks, beeches, sourwoods and oaks.

We'll eat at **The Olde Dutch Restaurant** in Logan. We DO NOT have reservations; however, they have always put us together. Take SR-664 south thru Logan to the restaurant, located on the west side of SR-664 just north of the US-33 interchange.
