Directions to Hike (Round Trip Distance 000 Miles):

From I-270 on the west side take the West Broad St exit. Drive 5 miles and turn left onto Darby Creek Rd. Continue 1.5 miles and turn left onto Kuhlwein Rd. The parking lot will immediately be on your left. There are no toilets at the trailhead but there are nice flush toilets in the Nature Center (the next road past Kuhlwein on Darby Creek Rd).

Hike Description:

The trail is an absolutely flat 12 foot wide crushed stone multi-use trail. At mile one, we will come to the old Darby Dan Farm Stables where John Galbreath bred and trained thoroughbred horses that won both the Kentucky Derby and the English Derby. There are benches to sit on. If you want you can return back to the parking lot for a 2 mile hike. Otherwise we will continue to the race track and walk around to the stone grandstands before returning on the same path for a total of 4 miles.

Suggested Items to Bring:

Water, Any comfortable walking shoe, Protection from sun (there is no shade on this hike). Dress for the weather.

Asian Buffet 5666 W Broad St, Columbus, OH 43228. Go North (right) up Darby Creek Rd and turn right onto Broad Street. The restaurant will be on your left in the strip mall on the northeast corner of Broad St and Galloway Rd. (behind the Walgreens)
