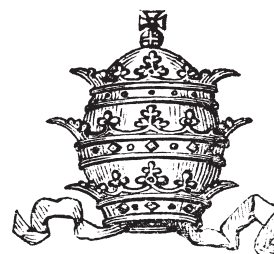

I announce to you a great joy: we have a Pope!

Robert Francis Cardinal Prevost was elected the 267th successor of St. Peter. He has taken on the name Leo XIV. Born in Chicago, Illinois, Cardinal Prevost was ordained as a priest for the Order of Saint Augustine in 1982. His service included extensive work in Peru from 1985 to 1986 and from 1988 to 1998, where he variously served as a parish pastor, diocesan official, seminary teacher, and administrator. Elected prior general of the Order of Saint Augustine from 2001 to 2013, he later, returned to Peru as Bishop of Chiclayo (2015–2023). In 2023, Pope Francis appointed him prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and president of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America, and made him a cardinal the same year.

A dual citizen of the United States and Peru, Leo is the first pope from North America and the first to be a Peruvian citizen. He is the first pope from the Order of Saint Augustine, and the seventh from orders following the Rule of Saint Augustine.

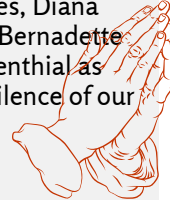

ALTAR FLOWER OFFERINGS AVAILABLE

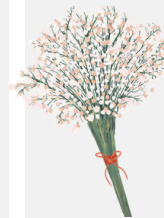
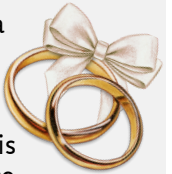

In the past, some families decided to park on the other side of Elmwood near city hall or in the parking ramp.



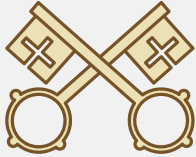
OCIA CLASS
