you to bring back to school on Monday. Percussion instruments and tubas will be loaded onto the trailer to be taken back to the High

School.

Please have a ride waiting for you at this time.

The night parade is MANDATORY for all field band members from 2024. This parade is also open to all alumni of the band as well as parents. If you know of someone that would like to march in the parade with us but didn't have a chance to come to the rehearsal, please have them call Mr. Jaeger and he can get them music. The only acceptable excuse to miss this parade is if you are going to be out of town for Thanksgiving.
