Show Day Itinerary:

9:00 AM- All Color Guard members arrive and put personal belongings in the Music Wing hallway. Get all equipment and go to the upper parking lot for practice.

9:15 AM- Color Guard rehearsal begins.

9:45 AM- Remainder of band report to Vets Park and leave personal belongings in Vet's Park.

- You must have your instrument in its case, your phone for UDB, and a water bottle.
- You will also need to bring everything for the competition with you.
- We will be loading instruments, etc., at Vets Park.

10:00 AM- Rehearsal starts for all winds, pit, and drumline.

11:30 AM- Color Guard moves to Vets Park. (Be at Vets Park at 11:45 AM.)

1:00 PM- Rehearsal ends. At this time, we ask that everyone be **all hands on deck** to get all pit equipment to the trailer.

- You need to pack your instruments and equipment.
- Student staff need to help load the trailer and then get ready to leave.
- The remainder of the band, after getting equipment to the proper place, will walk **TOGETHER** to the Junior-Senior High School and remain there until we leave.
- Once we arrive at the Junior-Senior High School, students will eat and change into their whites.

2:25 PM- Leave for Jordan-Elbridge High School from Medina Junior-Senior High School. We will stop for a bathroom break along the way.

4:50 PM- Arrive at Jordan-Elbridge High School.

At this time, you will be able to go to the bathroom and then report right back to the band trailer to get your uniform and change.

- Band boosters will tell you when and where you are able to change.
- There is to be **no messing around** from the time we arrive until after we perform.
- You have worked too hard to not be focused. Thank you!

5:30 PM- All members fully dressed with equipment and line up.

5:35 PM- Walk to warm-up.

5:40 PM- Warm-up in sections.

- Please understand that there will be other bands warming up right next to us or near us.
- Please stay focused and listen, as you do not want to miss instructions.

6:58 PM- Walk to the stadium.

7:08 PM- At the Gate.

7:18 PM- Medina Mustang performance.

7:40 PM- Return to the buses as a group and complete the following processes:

- All band members: put all hats in the hat boxes, gauntlets in the gauntlet boxes, and return your plume to the boosters.
- Put all equipment away and be helpful to the boosters in loading everything.
- Take off your uniform in the same location that you got dressed and change back into your street clothes for the remainder of the night.
- Return your uniform **properly on the hanger** to the uniform racks.

7:45 PM- You are free to return to the stadium to watch other bands and get some dinner.

- Everyone must travel in groups. No one is to walk alone. Remember, per the handbook and contract that you signed, all 7th-9th graders must be in groups of 4 or more, and all 10th-12th graders must be in groups of 2 or more at all times!
- In addition, no one is to stay back at the buses.
- The buses will be locked after the last person goes to the field.

8:30 PM- Retreat at the stadium.

We will sit as a group for retreat. The seniors in charge of finding a location for everyone to sit or stand together to watch retreat will be **Teagan Balaban and Lillian Maynard**. Please listen to where that location is and report there at this time.

Immediately Following the Awards- All members are to report back to the buses immediately for roll call and to prepare to leave for home.

9:45 PM- Leave for Medina Junior-Senior High School. We will stop for a bathroom break on the way home.

11:15 PM- Arrival at Medina Junior-Senior High School.

Before leaving for home, you are responsible for taking care of your own equipment and uniform.

- All student staff are required to help unload the trailer and put equipment in its place before leaving.
 - Once the trailers are unloaded and you have gotten the OK from a director, you are free to leave.
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Rules and Important Information:

1. All rules and regulations of the **Medina Central School Student Handbook** and the **Medina Mustang Band Student Handbook** will be adhered to at all times.
 - a. If any of these rules are broken during a band trip, you will be reported to the band directors and disciplined according to the consequences outlined in the handbooks.
 - b. A good rule of thumb: **If you know you shouldn't do it, don't do it.**
 - c. There are no warnings. Act accordingly and represent yourself, the band, and your school with pride and respect.
2. The band and all its members travel together to and from shows with transportation supplied by the school district.
 - a. If your parents wish to take you home from a performance, you will need to have a note to present to your chaperone prior to leaving Medina.
 - b. All parents will pick up their children from the buses **AFTER RETREAT (the awards ceremony)** and **sign out** with the chaperone chair before leaving. This is very important, as the directors are responsible for the members' well-being, safety, and return home. We appreciate your cooperation.
 - c. The only show where this does not take place is **Championships**. All members will ride to and from Championships with the band.
3. The maximum ticket price for all regular-season shows (does not include Championships) is **\$10 per sale**, available at drop-off on the day of the show from the boosters. Please go to the band room entrance for these tickets. Tickets at the door are **no more than \$12 each**.
