Saturday September 28th

- 9:15 am Everyone - Arrive at Vets by this time – Deposit uniform on uniform racks, put personal items by Oak Orchard, and get ready for rehearsal. Please have breakfast before you get here, that is a very important meal!!
- 9:30 am Rehearsal starts for everyone in sections
- 12:30 pm Rehearsal ends – Load instruments on instrument racks. Band managers and pit sections leader stay to help load trailer with boosters. EVERYONE should have something to eat!
- 1:30 pm Leave for Oswego HS (We will make a quick bathroom stop; I have added time for this.)
- 4:30 pm Arrive at Oswego HS
You are free to go to the bathroom and grab food at concessions. We will not have time after our performance to eat at concessions as we are last. Grab food and relax for a few minutes before we have to get ready.
- 5:40 pm Return to buses to get changed – Please remember white socks & white undergarments!
- 6:08 pm Dressed and lined-up for warm-up
- 6:18 pm Move to Warm-up area
- 6:28 pm Warm-up

- 8:30 pm Retreat and Awards – We are the last band on. I encourage you to bring a snack to eat as concessions will likely be closed once you change. – Drum Majors will need to be behind the visitor’s bleachers on the East side of the field right after our performance for retreat
- 9:00 pm Load buses for home
- 9:15 pm Leave Oswego for Medina. We will stop for food and to use the bathroom on the way home. Students should bring money for this, or a snack, as they will not have the option for concessions after the show.
- 12:15 am Arrive at Medina HS (This accounts for a 30 minute stop for food)
Everyone will help unload the trailer and the uniform bus. All uniforms are to go home with you and are to be taken out of the bag and hung up. Please do not leave it in a heap in the corner of your house. If your pants need to be cleaned, please have your parents do that as per the instructions given. If you have questions, please contact Mrs. Lenhart. ALL instruments are to be taken home as well.

- 5 Showing disrespect to other bands or other band members will not be tolerated. Everyone works hard to do their best, please be respectful and clap for all participants. Regardless of placement and score please be respectful and prideful!
