ATTENDANCE POLICY

Spring rehearsals are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:15-9pm at the High School. We understand that many students participate in a sport, dance, or may have another conflict. All we ask is that you try and make as many rehearsals as you possibly can. After you have arrived back from your game, you should grab something to eat, change into appropriate Marching Band attire, and join us for the rest of rehearsal. Communication is extremely important, so please make sure to communicate with Mr. Jaeger in advance.

All Mustang Band participants (this includes color guard) are <u>required</u> to attend all scheduled rehearsals and performances! Excused absences include: absent from school the day of the rehearsal, late due to a sporting event, or a family emergency. Work is not an acceptable reason to miss a rehearsal. Schedules are available well in advance, and extras are available for you to give to your boss. Please communicate with your job early on so that you are not scheduled during a rehearsal.

*Unexcused absence: absent from Marching Band, but attended school. Student did not communicate with Mr. Jaeger or Ms. Leno regarding their absence ahead of time.

2 UNEXCUSED ABSENCES WILL RESULT IN MEETING WITH THE BAND DIRECTOR TO DISCUSS YOUR ABSENCES AND TO SEE IF YOU WILL REMAIN IN THE BAND PROGRAM.

The Spring Season is a short season, so it is important that students attempt to make it to as many rehearsals as possible, even if it's the end of a rehearsal after a game. We understand that you are busy, but you have made a commitment to the band and we ask that you try and honor that commitment to the best of your ability, not for the staff, but for your teammates.

PERFORMANCES

All performances are mandatory. We work hard to make sure that all conflicts dealing with school and sports are taken care of, although this may not always work out. Please clear all of the following dates on your family and social calendars. If there are concerns, please talk with Mr. Jaeger ASAP.

UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Make sure your uniform is clean for ALL performances.

• UNIFORM PANTS - Can be washed. MUST be hung to dry. DO NOT PUT INTO DRYER!

SASHES – Do not wash!

- JACKETS -Take a wet wash cloth to it if needed. They can be DRY CLEANED ONLY! *Each uniform is dry-cleaned twice a year, paid for by the band boosters.
- INSIDE MATERIALS The neck guard should be unsnapped and washed in your washing machine. Hang it up to dry.
- GLOVES The booster uniform chairperson will take and wash after every performance.

SHOES – Your drill masters should be clean for every show.

 UNDERGARMENTS - Students performing MUST wear white undergarments. Colored undergarments will show thru the <u>white</u> uniform pants!!

• All band members need to wear a WHITE T-SHIRT under their uniform.

Please wear white tube socks or knee high white socks. No ankle or colored socks please!!
 JUDGES watch and look for this!

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

All Color Guard and Band Members – Guard or Marching Shoes = \$40 – If you are brand new you will be fitted for your shoes at uniform fittings in April and August. If you are a current member and your shoes are yellowing, are overly scuffed up with black marks or the toe or heel are not fully attached, it is time for a new pair.
