## **Proposal for New Workforce Development Partners Meeting**

Effective date: October, 2019

The current structure of Network4Health Workforce Committee meeting has been in place for nearly the whole duration of the waiver. While very helpful during the planning stages of the A1 project, engagement in the group has waned as implementation has moved forward. Having a cross-functional group committed to discussing workforce issues in the region still remains an important function. Therefore Network4Health will be ending the current committee make up and launching the new Network4Health Workforce Development Partners Meeting.

The focus of these meetings will be to understand trends happening in the training, hiring, retention and development of the region’s behavioral health workforce. This structure will be in place until the end of the waiver, December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

### **Structure:**

There will be no core group of members of this group; instead the meetings will be open to all senior and mid-level managers, HR staff, behavioral health education providers, and other staff as appropriate. The Director of Workforce Development will collect contact information of appropriate individuals to reach out to, but will also solicit additional names of stakeholders as meetings progress.

Meetings will be pre-scheduled from now until the end of the waiver, occurring approximately 5 times over the next 16 months. One hour is scheduled, however depending on topics and guest speakers, they may be extended to one and a half hours. Agendas will be decided prior to meetings, and will be sent out to stakeholders with enough notice. Meetings will be call-in or virtual, unless otherwise noted.
