Life-Study of Matthew - Study Guide

Dear brothers and sisters,

We will continue this week's truth pursuit with Message 53 of the *Life-study of Matthew*, entitled The Kingdom Requirements. In this message we come to 19:1-22, a portion in which Matthew places together certain incidents in Christ's life to show the requirements of the kingdom.

Here are some excerpts from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

"In ourselves we are not able to keep God's original ordination. For this, we need grace; we need God's gift. Only those who have received the gift of grace can accept the Lord's word regarding God's original ordination. A eunuch is one who deals thoroughly with lust. In order to be such a spiritual eunuch, we need grace. Only grace can afford us the strength and the supply to have a thorough dealing with lust. Lust is a great problem in our life. Because in ourselves we are not able to deal with this "scorpion," we need to look to the Lord and pray, "Lord, have mercy on me and grant me the grace I need." By grace it is possible to deal with the subtle, evil "scorpion" of lust that damages our life.

Only by the divine life can we fulfill the requirements of the kingdom. It is easy to fulfill these requirements when we have the grace to do so. By our human life it is impossible, but by the divine life with the divine grace it is easy. In fact, it is a joy. What a joy to lay up treasure in the heavens! We, the people in the kingdom, are altogether different from the worldly people. We are even different from those in Christianity. Our heart has been touched, and we are serious with the Lord concerning His kingdom. Riches and material possessions do not mean much to us. By our natural life it is very difficult to have such an attitude toward riches. But by the divine life with the divine grace, we can say that it is a joy for us to lay up treasure in the heavens."
