- **Gospel trips related to the 2026 Winter Olympics in Italy (12/4/2025 - 2/23/2026)**
 - The current Torch Relay (TR) and Olympic Games (OL) gospel trips are in progress.
 - Please pray for the Lord to prepare the hearts of seeking people to receive Christ in His word and be added to the Lord's testimony in Italy. And new local churches to be raised up, and existing churches to be strengthened.
