Life-Study of Matthew - Study Guide

Dear brothers and sisters,

We will continue this week's truth pursuit with message 63 of the Life-Study of Matthew, "THE PROPHECY OF THE KINGDOM (3)." This portion in Matthew 24:32 through 25:30 is another section of the prophecy of the kingdom, the section concerning the church. Here in His prophecy, the Lord turns from the Jews to the believers.

Here is an excerpt from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

"Matthew 24:32—25:30 is concerned with the church. In this portion of the Word, everything spoken by the Lord is related to two matters: watchfulness and readiness, and faithfulness and prudence. In chapter twenty-four watchfulness and readiness is covered in verses 32 through 44, and faithfulness and prudence in verses 45 through 51. In chapter twenty-five, the parable of the virgins illustrates watchfulness, and the parable of the talents illustrates faithfulness. All this is related to us. We need to watch and be ready for the Lord's coming back so that we may be raptured earlier. We also need to be faithful and prudent in serving the Lord so that we may receive the reward. Thus, watchfulness is for the early rapture, and faithfulness is for reward." (Witness Lee, Life-study of Matthews, Living Stream Ministry, Anaheim, CA, msg. 63)

Questions:

1. How is verse 32, concerning the fig tree, a sign to the believers?
2. From verse 34, contrast the two kinds of generations.
3. What were the most striking features of the days before the flood?
4. In verses 40-41, one was taken and the other left. Explain how we know that both men and both women were believers?
