TESA Community Services Award Guidelines Due by April 25, 2023

Community service is the spirit of Elkdom within each of our communities. Every community has some common needs and others have unique needs based on their geographic location and demographics. Community service builds pride in our members-a proud member stays a member. Every Lodge strives to meet needs in their communities that demonstrate the motto "Elks Care – Elks Share".

TESA Bylaws: "Section 10.030.5: ELKS COMMUNITY SERVICES: The purpose of this committee is to stimulate and assist the Lodges in initiating and continuing community service activities in the Lodge area."

Think about all of the support your Lodge provides for your local community and document your activities. The following criteria should be used when completing contest form TESA Community Services Booklet. Please follow the instructions listed below:

The judging guides, with the point values, will be on the TESA website and a link will be sent out in the TESA newsletter. Both will be done by the fall of 2022.

When "Media" is used it can be newspaper, website, and/or Facebook. Let us know what your lodge uses to get the word out about your community services work.

On an annual basis each Lodge should assess the needs in their communities to determine what community services they would like to continue and also what newly identified or emerging needs they might want to address and budget for the year

Community service is the true essence of our Charity work. I hope each and every Lodge will put together an entry for the Contest. Sharing what we, as Elks, do throughout the year, is an important part of spreading the news about the good works of Elkdom and improves our image in the local communities that we serve.

TESA Community Service Award Guidelines

Booklet should include:

- 1. All articles must be community interest and related to the programs and activities of the Order.
- 2. All media articles must contain a reference to the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks. Media can be newspaper, website or Facebook.
- Judging will be conducted on articles for the current Lodge year only. (Be sure your Lodge Secretary provides a letter documenting Lodge membership on April 1st of the current year).
- 4. Programs the Judges will be looking for do not need to be the order listed below.
- The booklet folder can be anything your lodge feels can be used to show your Community Services and share at all functions.
- 6. The binder covers will be judged. Get creative!
- The following is to be used as a guide only (other programs may be substituted for the following listed). Additional programs will be judged as indicated in "Additional Material Which Will Be Judged" listed below.
