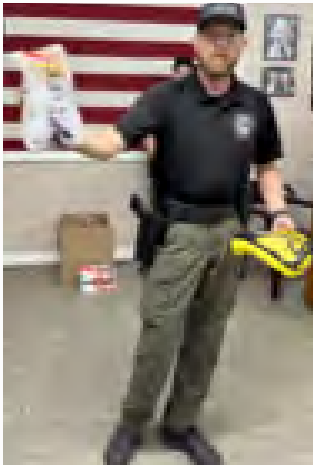

★ GENERAL RULES ★

1. Cook-off officially opens at 7:00 a.m. Saturday.
2. ALL entries must be cooked on the premises on the day of the cook-off. Cooking may begin upon completion of inspection.
3. Brisket/Entry Competition - Cook-off officially opens at 7:00 a.m. Saturday, those who prefer to begin cooking their brisket earlier than 7:00 a.m., starting any time after NOON on Friday. Please notify the chairman accordingly so arrangements can be made to get your team registered and your ingredients inspected.
4. All cooking must be done from scratch, including seasonings, etc., must not be cold or chopped in advance, but must not be mixed prior to inspection. Nothing may be turned in from the container issued by the Cook-Off Committee.
5. Space assigned on first come, first served basis. Booths may not exceed 20'x30', 12' deep. Exceptions must be cleared with the Chairman.
6. Entry fees as set forth on entry form must be paid prior to container pick up.
7. Each team must provide their own tables and chairs.
8. This cook-off is open to ELK FAMILIES ONLY. Inspectors will ask to see membership cards.
9. Butane and Coleman stoves may be used, but NO OPEN FIRES are permitted.
10. Common sense sanitary conditions must prevail at all times.
11. Garbage bag will be provided. Keep the cooking area clean and free of trash at all times.
12. While breaking down your booth and taking the cook-off area, remove everything that was brought in, including any lumber, hay bales, etc. If it was not there when you arrived, it should not be there when you leave.
13. Elks are American gentlemen and women and are expected to conduct themselves accordingly. Disorderliness of any team member could lead to the disqualification of the entire team. The head cooks are responsible for the actions of their team.

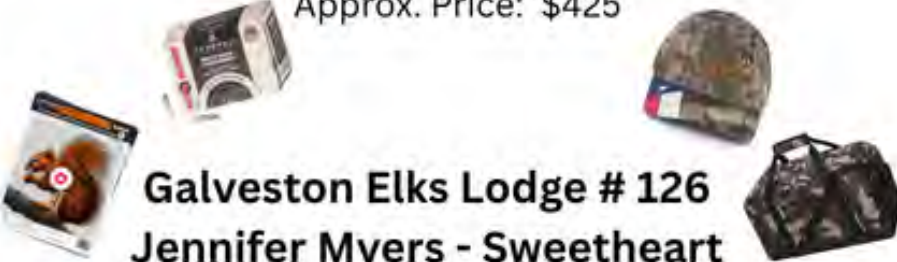
