WHO WE ARE

The Church Service Center (CSC) is a non-profit organization, incorporated in April 1993 by a group of community members and local churches (Avon Park Ministerial Association). CSC is a food pantry ministry supported completely by volunteers and generous donations from local residents, businesses, social groups, churches, and the USDA. Our goal is to provide free food, clothing, and household goods for those in need. When finances permit we also provide assistance with utilities, rent, prescriptions, and temporary shelter. In 2019 we served over 5,000 families representing approximately 10,000 individuals in the community. In addition, we provide referral information regarding social service organizations that offer assistance not provided by CSC.

HOW TO QUALIFY

Any resident of Highlands County, that meets USDA eligibility requirements can apply and become a client of CSC. In accordance with Florida Privacy Act, all client information is kept confidential.



WHERE TO DONATE

- Donations of food are collected at local churches, food drives, or CSC
- Donations of men, women, and children's clothing, as well as household items can be delivered to CSC during hours of operation.
- Financial donations can be sent to our mailing address or delivered to CSC personally during regular business hours.
- As a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation, all donations made to CSC are **tax deductible**.
