# New Skilled Trades Academy Receives Grant Support

The Ottawa County Business Advisory Council implemented the first ever Ottawa County Skilled Trades Academy at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year. Thirteen seniors from five school districts including Danbury, Port Clinton, Oak Harbor, Genoa, and Woodmore,

make up the inaugural class. The students will explore HVAC, electrical, welding, carpentry, auto mechanics, and maintenance throughout the year. The Skilled Trades Academy, an expansion of the BAC's Career Engagement Opportunities Internship Program, would not have been possible without the help of the Ottawa County Community Foundation. A \$38,750.00 grant from the Special Initiatives Support Fund for Schools of the OCCF was awarded to support this unique initiative. Jim Lippert, Skilled Trades Academy Program Instructor, and Jamie Beier Grant, Ottawa County Improvement Corporation (OCIC) Director, accepted the check at the recent OCIC Annual Meeting.
